ADRIAN – Isaiah D. Mehan, Jr., 80, of Clayton, passed away Saturday, February 5, 2011, at Bixby Medical Center.

Isaiah “Junior” was born September 30, 1930, the youngest child of Isaiah and Emma (Dickerson) Mehan, Sr. He graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1949. During the Korean Conflict, he served as a Corporal in the United States Army.

On December 30, 1953, Isaiah married Barbara L. White in Angola, Indiana. Barbara, his loving wife of 57 years, survives.

Junior retired from Hydro (Bohn) Aluminum in 1993 after 44 years. He was a member of Sand Creek Community Church and it’s Joyful Senior Group. He was also a member of the American Legion, Pheasants Forever and Sand Creek Athletic Boosters.

Isaiah lived in Deerfield for ten years then moved to their “Rolling Hills Farm” where he enjoyed having the kids, grandkids and great grandkids go sledding on the north hill, going for walks, and riding the “gator” through the woods. He always enjoyed playing cards, watching the sons, grandkids and their friends playing sports, and attending all Sand Creek events. Junior enjoyed hunting with his sons and grandsons, traveling to the Amish areas, cutting wood, and
