



## Rev. J. Daniel Frost

March 31, 1942 - February 25, 2022

WALNUT CREEK, OHIO – Rev. J. Daniel Frost, 79, of Walnut Creek, OH, formerly of Adrian, MI, died early Friday morning, February 25, 2022 at Cleveland Clinic Mercy Hospital, Canton, OH.

Dan was born on March 31, 1942, in Urbana, OH to James and Nina (Page) Frost. He graduated from Columbus West High School in 1960 and went on to receive his bachelor's degree at Malone College in Canton, OH. Dan continued his studies at the Nazarene Theological Seminary in Kansas City, Missouri.

On April 20, 1968 Dan married Wanda Eileen Cramer in Adrian and they celebrated over 46 years together before her death on February 8, 2015. Family vacations were going on road trips to visit family and friends in various states and stopping at every garage sale along the way. Dan played the piano and accordion throughout his life, entertaining his family and those around him.

Dan dedicated his life to spreading the Lord's word and the message of the Gospel, serving 7 churches as pastor in the Evangelical Friends denomination:

- Pelham Friends Church in Ontario, Canada
- Raisin Center Friends Church in Adrian

- Trinity Friends Church in Lisbon, OH
- Morningside Friends Church in Port St. Lucie, FL
- Westside Friends Church in Kansas City, KS
- North Olmsted Friends Church in North Olmsted, OH
- Brewster Friends Church in Brewster, OH

He served on mission trips to India, Hong Kong, Taipei, Greece and the Holy Land. Dan and Wanda lead missionary trips to Jamaica for 10 years, where he would encourage and teach the pastors of all the congregations in the area. He also worked for several years at Paxton Ministries with the assisted living community in Harrisburg, PA.

He is survived by his sons, James Frost of Chicago, IL, and Joseph (Shannon) Frost of Jackson, MS; grandchildren, Nina, Darby, Emory, Beau and Violet Frost; and siblings, Linda McVicker and Douglas Frost. Dan was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Wanda; and brother, David.

A funeral service for Rev. Frost will take place on Friday, March 4, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. at the Raisin Center Friends Church, Adrian, with his nephew, Pastor Chris Cramer officiating. Burial will follow at Lenawee Hills Memorial Gardens, Tecumseh. Visitation will be held on Thursday, March 3, 2022 from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Wagley Funeral Home, Adrian.
