TECUMSEH – Jack R. Gillin, age 82 of Adrian, passed away peacefully Wednesday, February 12, 2014 at Cambrian Assisted Living.

He was born July 14, 1931, in Conemaugh, Pennsylvania, to Merton and Jenny (Sensabaugh) Gillin. Jack graduated from Tecumseh High School in 1949 and attended Manchester College in Indiana. He served in the United States Navy during the Korean Conflict.
