ADRIAN- Jaime Nicol Dillon, age 48, of Adrian, MI went home to be with Jesus on May 14, 2024, while she was at the family home under care of her loving parents.

Jaime was born on March 20, 1976, in Youngstown, Ohio, the daughter of Harlan “Dean” and Debbie (Stevens) Dillon. Jaime graduated in 1995 from George Jenkins High School in Lakeland, Florida.

After high school, Jaime provided extra support and was a wonderful caregiver to her grandparents for many years. She went on to work at Kmart and Lowe’s in Adrian for several years. Jaime had a strong faith in the Lord and demonstrated this daily. Over the years, Jaime belonged to Ogden Community Church and attended Crossroads Community Church and New Life Common Church. She enjoyed reading and was always in the middle of a story.

In 2004, Jaime was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis and for the next 20 years she battled a debilitating disease while continuing to be a positive light to others. During her fight with MS, Jaime became wheelchair bound, had to stop working and eventually lost the ability to hold books while reading. These limitations did not stop Jaime from living her life and adapting, such as becoming a regular listener to audio books. Jaime’s love for the Lord was evident to those around her and confirmed with the smile she was so willing to give to others.

In addition to her parents, Jaime is survived by numerous aunts, uncles and

cousins; a special uncle, Greg (Ingrid) Stevens; her church friends which were like her second family; and her dear friend from middle school, Janda Smith. A memorial service for Jaime will be held on Saturday, May 18, 2024, at 11:00 a.m. at Ogden Community Church with Pastor Brandon Rickard officiating. Visitation will take place on Friday, May 17, 2024, from 4 to 8 p.m. at Wagley Funeral Home, Adrian.
