



James "Jim" B. Hazen Jr.

Rockford- James "Jim" B. Hazen Jr. passed away peacefully on November 10, 2023 in Rockford, MI surrounded by his family. He was just shy of his 98th birthday. Jim was born on December 24th, 1925 to James B. Hazen and Charlotte (Sabin) Hazen in Hudson, MI. Jim married Barbara Hintz on June 21, 1953, celebrating their 70th anniversary this past summer. Jim is survived by his wife Barbara and his four children, Jim (Sara), Ann (Rich), Jane (Steve) and Sally, as well as, six grandchildren and six and a half great grandchildren. He is also survived by his sister Mary Enerson and preceded in death by his brother Richard (Dick).

Jim, a proud World War II veteran, was awarded the Silver Star and Purple Heart as a Sergeant in the US Army. He organized many reunions for the 100th Infantry Company G and prepared a monthly newsletter for them.

Jim graduated from Michigan State in 1949 with a degree in civil engineering. He began his career as half owner of Hazen Goodrich Construction Company. He went on to work for Kewaunee Scientific Equipment Company for 15 years in Adrian, MI before transferring to Statesville, NC with them. He retired while in Statesville and then became co-owner of Glen Eagle Manufacturing Company. Jim and Barbara returned to Adrian in 2001 and remained there until 2022.

Jim was an Adrian community leader, holding many high level posts in The American Legion, Lenawee Country Club, Rotary (Adrian and Statesville), Lenawee YMCA, and Adrian Chamber of Commerce.

Jim was noted for his sense of humor and sharp wit. He loved his family, Michigan State University, golfing, bowling nights followed by gin rummy, and a good manhattan. He was an avid woodworker. His children and grandchildren have priceless items built from the most organized workshop imaginable.

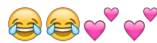
“ Dear Barbara, Jim, Ann, Jane, and Sally,
