PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLORIDA – James F. Pierce, 82, of Adrian, passed away unexpectedly, Wednesday, April 14, 2010 in Florida.

Jim was born April 20, 1927, in Adrian, the son of Leon F. and Mary L. (Swank) Pierce. He graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1945. Jim received his Bachelor's Degree from Albion College. During World War II, Jim was stationed in Germany while serving in the United States Air Force.

On August 14, 1949, Jim married Doris Kimball in Adrian. Doris, his wife of over 60 years, survives.

Jim worked for Bohn Aluminum which later became Gulf + Western in Adrian, Danville, IL, Detroit, and lastly in New York City where he retired in 1984 as Senior Vice President and Corporate Controller. Jim and Doris returned to Adrian and enjoyed summers in Cheboygan and winters in Naples. Jim collected antique sporting goods and turned his hobby into a small business he and Doris could do together.

Jim was an active member of the First United Methodist Church.

In addition to his wife, Jim is survived by three sons: Gregory (Cindy) Pierce of
