



Jane Ann Ingold Tuckerman

December 4, 1932 - December 16, 2025

BLISSFIELD- Jane Ann Ingold Tuckerman, age 93, passed peacefully at her home on the evening of December 16, 2025, with family by her side under the care of Hospice of Lenawee. She was born December 4, 1932, in Adrian, Michigan, the only child of Anna Mary Murbach and Arthur John Ingold.

Jane spent her early childhood in Riga and later in Blissfield, graduating from Blissfield High School in 1950. She attended Stephens College in Columbia, Missouri, and then transferred to the University of Michigan. Upon his return from serving in Korea, Jane and Walter I. Tuckerman were married. The young couple moved briefly to California, returning home to focus on raising a family and growing the family farm in the mid-1950s.

She earned her Bachelor of Fine Arts from Siena Heights College in 1971 and devoted herself to the Blissfield community. She helped to found the garden club, local historical society, and worked to preserve the Blissfield Hotel after the fire. She also was a long-time dealer of antiques, having several shops over the years including Treasures and Pleasures in downtown Blissfield. She greatly enjoyed refinishing pieces and connecting with other collectors spanning many decades.

Throughout her life, Jane loved Scottish Terriers and Morgan Horses, especially sharing her passion with her two daughters and granddaughter Elizabeth. The Ingold family farm was recognized as a Michigan Centennial and, most recently, a Sesquicentennial Farm—an achievement Jane treasured deeply.

Jane "Grammy" is lovingly remembered by her three children, John (Bonnie), Jana (Ken) Beck, and Ann (Mark) Keller; her grandchildren, Katy (Theo) Engel, Jacob Tuckerman, Elizabeth Keller, John Keller, Craig Beck, Ryan Beck, and Theresa Klinge; and her great-grandchildren, Dreu Tuckerman, Walker Engel, and Leo Engel.
