



## Janet Marion Rodgers

January 9, 1933 - March 11, 2019

ADRIAN- Janet Marion Rodgers, age 86 of Adrian, passed away on Monday, March 11, 2019, at home with her family by her side.

Janet was born on January 9, 1933, in Adrian to Richard and Marion (Cline) Hartung. In 1954, she married Richard Harrison Rodgers and they celebrated 46 years together before his death in 2000.

Janet devoted her life to her family and her artwork. She attended Siena Heights College in the early 1950's and returned in 1994, at the age of 61, to complete her Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree. An accomplished artist, Janet's work was accepted at the Toledo Museum of Art during amateur showings and she also taught Art at the Lenawee Vo-Tech Center for several years. Janet with her sisters, Betty and Marcia, ran an antique shop in Tecumseh called "The Old Junque Shop."

She enjoyed traveling with her beloved husband, Dick, and would often go to Cape Cod. Some of her most memorable times included collecting antiques, eating seafood and sitting on the beach with a sketch book in her hand.

Janet is survived by her sons, Daniel Rodgers of Bradenton, Florida and Richard (Julie) Rodgers of Manitou Beach.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband Dick and son, John Robert Rodgers.

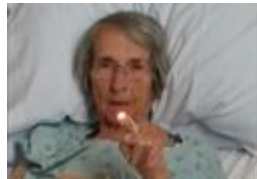
