Jean Thomson (Goodfellow) Andrews, age 89, of Howland Corners, Ohio, and Duck, North Carolina, passed away peacefully under the tender care of Hospice of Lenawee, the staff of Charlotte Stephenson Manor, and her family, in Adrian, Michigan on Sunday, August 14, 2016.

Jean was born on December 4, 1926, to Agnes (Munsie) and Robert Goodfellow in Cleveland, Ohio. Her parents were from Glasgow, Scotland, and Jean always took great pride in her Scottish heritage.

Jean grew up in Cleveland and attended West Technical High School. She graduated from Bowling Green State University where she attained a Bachelor of Science Degree in elementary teaching. She met her husband, David Andrews, at Bowling Green. After her graduation, she taught second grade in Cleveland until her marriage to David on June 21, 1950, in Cleveland, Ohio.

She moved to Howland Corners after her marriage where her husband David co-owned and operated Andrews Shopping Center with his brother Harmon. Jean taught first grade at Howland Elementary School until the birth of her first child. In 1957, in order to provide a kindergarten experience for her children and other children in Howland, she founded a private kindergarten at Howland Community Church. She taught and administered the kindergarten until 1961

when Howland Schools initiated their first kindergarten classes and invited Jean to be their first kindergarten teacher. She taught in Howland Schools until 1983, when she took on full-time care of her parents. During the 1960s, Jean was also the leader of Girl Scout Troop 463 in Howland. In addition, she was an active member of Howland Community Church from 1950 to 2010, when she came to live near her daughter in Adrian.

In 1970, she and her family began visiting the Outer Banks of North Carolina, and in 1982, she and Dave built a house on Sea Tern Drive in Duck. She and Dave were active there in the Duck United Methodist Church and the Duck Woods Country Club as well as in neighborhood activities with her many friends on Sea Tern.

Jean was a friendly, generous, and helpful person with a wide circle of friends whom she loved dearly. Above all, she loved her family.

Jean is survived by her daughter Diane (Ken) Henningfeld of Adrian; her son Craig (Patti) Andrews of Howland; her grandchildren Kate (Ross) Fort of East Lansing, Michigan; Anne (Michael Garner) Henningfeld of Adrian; Ian (Jaime) Andrews of Cleveland; and Emily (Vincent) Procopio of Poland, Ohio. She is also survived by her three great-grandchildren, David and Thomson Fort of East Lansing, and Owen Andrews of Cleveland. In addition, she is survived by her brother Allan Goodfellow of Avon Lake, Ohio. She was preceded in death by her parents, and by her beloved husband David in 1999.
