June 25, 1947 - January 5, 2023

OMAHA, NEBRASKA - Jeffrey LaBarr, formerly of Adrian, MI, now living in Omaha, NE, passed away with family at his side on Thursday, January 5, 2023, after a several years long battle against Lewy Body Dementia.

Jeff was born on June 25, 1947, in Adrian, Michigan. Jeff primarily grew up in Adrian with a small stint in North Carolina. Jeff graduated from Adrian High School in 1966, then spent two years at Michigan State University. Jeff hired on to the Adrian Police Department in 1974, where he served the community proudly until 2004, retiring with 30 years on the job. He was a member of the VFW Annis Fint Post #1584, American Legion Post #97, and the 40 & 8. Jeff was also proud to be included in the PGA, the Patterson Golf Association.

He was married to his wife, Claudia, for 42 years and together they raised two children. Daughter Catherine Muck, and Brian, both formerly of Adrian and now living in Omaha, NE. Jeff was the proud grandfather to six grandchildren: Andrew, David, Matthew (Kaylee) Thompson; Kooper Popejoy; Alexandra and Caroline LaBarr; and four great grandchildren.

Jeff was preceded in death by his father, Leonard Roswell LaBarr, his mother Dorothy Fischer LaBarr, step-mother Gwendolyn LaBarr, and his grandson Matthew Thompson. He is survived by his loving wife Claudia and children Catherine (Ed) and Brian (Therese).
