Jo Linda truly enjoyed her retirement. She actively volunteered and supported the Disabled American Veterans and was the State Commander of the State Department from 2016-2017 for the organization. Veterans and their care and support was a cause very near and dear to Jo Linda's heart. She also supported the local VFW and the American Legion.

In her spare time Jo Linda enjoyed gardening. She was active in her children's

lives – supporting the Pennsbury (Pennsylvania) High School Marching Band in their Boosters and was a Girl Scout Leader.

Jo Linda is survived by her daughters Jennifer (Joshua) Manning and Jacquelyn (Benjamin) Prince; her son, Jeremy Norton; six grandchildren, Sage, Siara, Teagan, Jared, Jocelyn, and Kellan; and her brothers, Ricky (Michelle) Cutler and Randy Cutler.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her sister, Jody Cutler.

Services for Jo Linda will be private. Wagley Funeral Home, Adrian has been entrusted with arrangements. She will be laid to rest at the Great Lakes National Cemetery in Holly, MI.
