ANN ARBOR – John C. Gorski, 58, of Blissfield, passed away Saturday, December 24, 2011, at University of Michigan Hospital.

He was born January 4, 1953, in Toledo, Ohio, the son of Francis and Dorothy (Banko) Gorski. John graduated from St. Francis High School in Toledo.

On March 30, 1979, John married Jayne Grinage in Blissfield. Jayne, his wife of 32 years, survives.

John worked as a mechanic, a salesman for Bill Crispin Chevrolet for many years, and most recently, for Blissfield Community Schools. He was an active member of the Blissfield First United Methodist Church where he served on several committees. He enjoyed playing cards, fishing, and playing golf.
