ONSTED – Keith Brown, age 81 of Onsted, joined his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, October 22, 2024, at the Henry Ford Jackson Hospital.

Keith was born on September 9, 1943, in Estherville, Iowa to Vernon and Sylvia (Hiles) Brown, making up one-fourth of the Brown boys. He graduated in 1961 from Lincoln Central High School in Gruver, Iowa.
