ADRIAN—Kelvin Lee Cook, 41 of Adrian, passed away Friday, May 27, 2016. He was born in Adrian to Douglas Cook and Rita (Bennett) Estep on July 11, 1974. On June 28, 1997, he married Alicia Stroud, who survives.

Kelvin was a 1992 graduate of Berean Baptist Academy and a 1996 Hyles-Anderson College graduate. He served as Assistant Pastor at Berean Baptist Church for 10 years, where he worked in the Senior Citizen Ministries. Most recently he was employed at Mahar Tool Supply Company in Dundee. 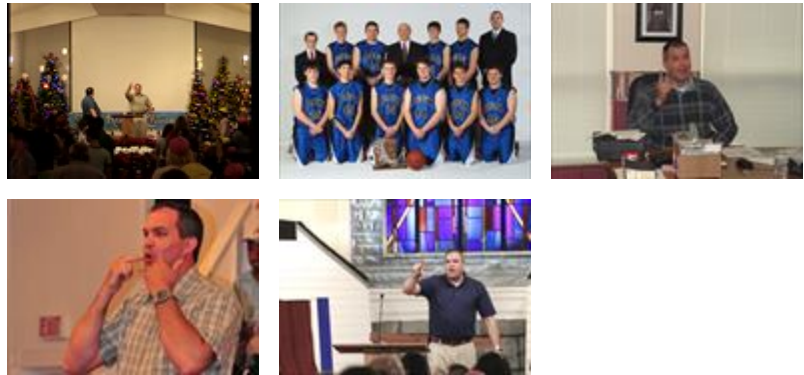

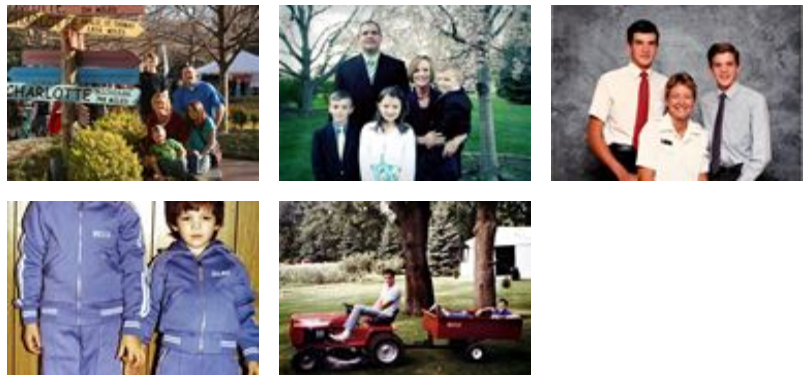
