BLISSFIELD – Kenneth A. Sauter, 88, of Blissfield, passed away, Tuesday, May 24, 2011 surrounded by his loving family.

Ken was born on January 16, 1923 in Jackson, Michigan to August P. and Irene (Weeks) Sauter. He served in the U.S. Coast Guard from 1942-1946 and fought in the Pacific Theatre during World War II. On May 18, 1946 he married Eileen Ruede.

Ken worked for Consumer Power Company for over 38 Years, retiring in 1985. He was one of the founders of Blissfield Little League in 1957 and has been inducted into the Little League Hall of Fame. He was active in the American Legion and also at his church, St. Peter the Apostle. He was a past member of Kiwanis and bowled regularly. Ken loved his family and enjoyed being involved in his grandchildren's activities.

Ken is survived by his wife, Eileen, of 65 years; and his seven sons, Dave (Becky) of Lambertville, Tom (Karen) of Mokena, IL, Bill (Dena) of Grand Lake, CO, Dan (Laura) of Palmyra, Greg (Bev) of Palmyra, Tim of Palmyra, and Keith (Julie) of Muskegon; 19 grandchildren, and 13 great grandchildren, with one more on the way. Ken is also survived by his sister Sally (Tom) Beasley of Jackson as well as Sally's three sons.

Ken is preceded in death by his parents, and two siblings, Bill and Phyllis.
