



## Kristine A. Foor

November 25, 1952 - October 21, 2017

ADRIAN – Kristine A. Foor, age 64 of Adrian, passed away Saturday, October 21, 2017, at her home after boldly battling multiple sclerosis for 15 years.

She was born November 25, 1952, in Adrian, Michigan, the only daughter of Robert and Panka (Danchoff) Kaiser. She attended Catholic Central, and graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1970. Kris went on to earn a Bachelors Degree in Library Science from Western Michigan University and a Masters Degree in Elementary Education from Eastern Michigan University.

On July 10, 1976, Kris married Edward Foor in Adrian, and shared 41 years together.

Kris taught third grade at Onsted Elementary School for 10 years before working as a librarian for Michener Elementary School in Adrian. She was a faithful member of St. Joseph Catholic Church. Kris was a fan of both University of Michigan and Michigan State University basketball and football. She enjoyed being athletic, playing city league softball and volleyball for several years. Kris served as the secretary for the local multiple sclerosis support group. She spent many years researching family genealogy in her spare time.

In addition to her husband, Ed, Kris is survived by their children, Nathan and his fiance, Natalie Smith, and Melissa and her fiance Colin Molloy, both of Seattle, WA; brothers, Stephen (Marty) Kaiser of Stow, OH; Roby Kaiser of Lake Worth, FL, and Tom (Andy) Kaiser of Sacramento, CA; and several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents.

A Memorial Mass will take place at 11:00 a.m., Thursday, October 26, 2017 at St. Joseph Catholic Church. The family will receive friends at the church Thursday from 10:00 a.m. until the service.
