TOLEDO, OHIO - Larry E. Zeluff, 74, of Adrian, passed away Friday, September 17, 2010, at Toledo Hospital, surrounded by family and friends

Larry was born March 9, 1936, in Adrian, the son of Lawrence and Margueritte (Shaler) Zeluff. He graduated from Adrian High School

On October 13, 1962, Larry married Elaine Loveland in Palmyra. Elaine, his wife of over 48 years, survives.

Larry worked for General Motors for over 30 years. He started at Fisher Body in Tecumseh, and retired in 1995 from Power Train in Toledo. He enjoyed monthly gatherings at the UAW hall with fellow retirees. Larry was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church.
