



Lawrence "Tibb" Bowerman

June 2, 1934 - February 19, 2023

ADRIAN – Lawrence “Tibb” Bowerman, age 88 of Adrian, died Saturday, February 18, 2023, at Lenawee Medical Care Facility.

He was born June 2, 1934, to Harley and Esther (Sortor) Bowerman. After graduating from Delta High School, he proudly served in the United States Navy during the Korean War.

On April 24, 1953, he married June Price and she survives, having celebrated close to 70 wonderful years together. During those years they enjoyed traveling to the Upper Peninsula and spending many winters in Florida.

Tibb grew up in Delta, Ohio, moving to Adrian in 1955 to work at American Chain and Cable where he retired with 37 years of service. He was a faithful member of the Blissfield Baptist Church and always looked forward to the men’s prayer breakfast. Tibb was also a huge Ohio State fan.

In addition to his wife June, he is survived by their children, Steve Bowerman, Cheryl (Brion) Crawford, and Karen Bowerman; numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren; and a sister, Nancy Miller. He was preceded in death by a son, Larry Bowerman; grandson, Keith Bowerman; brothers, Chuck, Tom, Conrad, Harley and John; and sisters, Romaine and Martha.

Funeral services will take place at 11 a.m., Wednesday, February 22, 2023, at the Blissfield Baptist Church with Pastor Tom Frantz officiating. Burial will follow at Lenawee Hills Memorial Park with military honors by VFW Annis Fint Post #1484 and American Legion Post #97. Visitation will be held at the church Wednesday from 10 a.m. until the service.
