



## Leo Martinal

December 18, 1926 - January 24, 2009

ADRIAN – Leo M. Martinal, age 82 of Adrian, passed away at his home Saturday, January 24, 2009, surrounded by his family.

Leo was born December 18, 1926 in Palmyra Township, the youngest child of Joseph and Mary (Rose) Martinal. During World War II, he served his country in the Army.

Leo married Virginia Mattocks on January 8, 1950 in Onsted. Virginia, his wife of 59 years, survives.

Leo worked for Bohn Aluminum, now known as Hydro, as a quality control inspector. He retired in 1988 after 44 years of service. An avid outdoorsman, Leo enjoyed camping, hunting and fishing. He was also a great gardener. For seven years Leo served as Scout Master for Troop #59, now Troop #659, sharing his passion for the outdoors with many young men. He attended both Springville and Hudson United Methodist Churches.

In addition to his wife, Leo is survived by one son, Dale and his wife Mary Martinal of Adrian; two grandsons, Paul (Becky) Martinal of Adrian and Tim (Patti) Martinal of Cedar Springs, MI; and three great grandchildren, Dylan, Taylor and Jacob.
