Wauseon, OH: Leslie L. Jack, age 70, of Englewood, Florida, formerly of Wauseon, Ohio passed away Tuesday, August 9, 2011 in Celina, Tennessee while on vacation.

Les was born on September 22, 1940 in Edon, Ohio, the son of Cleo and Donna (Shaffer) Jack. He was a 1958 graduate of Edon High School in Edon, Ohio. On July 8, 1989 Les was united in marriage to Diane Roback. He retired from GM Powertrain in Defiance, Ohio after 35 years of service. 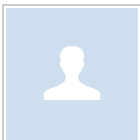
