BLISSFIELD—Lewis J. (“Lewie”) Beagle, 78, of Blissfield, passed away on Tuesday, March 31, 2020 at Ebeid Hospice Center in Sylvania, OH. He was born at Bixby Hospital in Adrian, MI on August 15, 1941 to Daniel C. and Lucille (Demusky) Beagle. He graduated from Blissfield High School in 1959 and began his life long career as a farmer in Riga and Ogden Townships. On June 22, 1963, he married Judy Robertson, who survives.
