



## Linda H. Feeney

October 28, 1931 - September 18, 2018

ADRIAN – Linda H. Feeney died on September 18, 2018, age 86, at Hospice of Lenawee in Adrian, Michigan.

Linda was born October 28, 1931, in Indianapolis, Indiana. She was the daughter of Benjamin L. and Florence C. (Buffkin) Harrison. She leaves behind her husband of 65 years, James L. Feeney, M.D. They were married August 8, 1953 at St. Anne's Catholic Church in New Castle, Indiana. Linda is also survived by her four loving daughters: Dianne Feeney of New York City, Deborah Feeney (Todd) Spencer of Adrian, Lisa Kridner (David Kridner, deceased) of Austin, Texas and Sarah Feeney of Adrian. Continuing the tradition of women in the family, she is the proud grandmother of Corinne (Brandon) Kruse, Emily (Aaron) Van Y, Whitney (Tyler) Serafini, Lauren (John) Lanier, and Natalie James Kridner; and great granddaughters, Sage and June Serafini.

Most of Linda's young life was spent in New Castle, Indiana, where she graduated high school in 1949. She graduated from Indiana University in 1953 with a Bachelor's Degree specializing in speech and hearing therapy. While in college she was a member of Delta Gamma Sorority, and Phi Theta Delta educational honorary fraternity.

James and Linda moved to Adrian in 1962 and she was a board member of Lenawee Community Mental Health for 30 years as well as on the board of the Adrian Symphony and the Croswell Opera House. Linda was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church. Additionally she was a member of Kappa Kappa

Epsilon, Alpha Omega study club, and Literate Ladies Book Club. She enjoyed activities with her friends including playing bridge.

A memorial mass will take place at 10 a.m., Saturday, September 29, 2018, at St. Mary's Catholic Church with Rev. Timothy McIntire presiding. The family will receive friends Friday, September 28, 2018, from 3 to 7 p.m., at Wagley Funeral Home. Visitation will also be held at the church on Saturday from 9 to 9:45 a.m.
