BLISSFIELD – Lois L. Piotter, age 91 of Blissfield, passed away Sunday, December 31, 2017 at Toledo Hospital surrounded by her family.

She was born March 7, 1926, in Adrian, MI, one of the nine children of Clarence and Lois (Bushey) Stites.

On June 30, 1945, she married Richard J. Piotter, and he preceded her in death in 1988 after sharing over 43 years together.

Lois worked at Tecumseh Products, AJ Plastics, and also had her own house and office cleaning business. She was an active member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church where she taught Sunday school and was involved in the sewing circle. Lois was a Cub Scout and Blue Bird Leader. She enjoyed bowling and served as secretary of the WIBC for several years.
