SYLVANIA, OHIO – Louise M. Sayler, 89, of Blissfield, passed away peacefully, surrounded by her loving family, Wednesday, December 8, 2010 at Kingston Residence in Sylvania.

Louise was born September 30, 1921, in Blissfield, the daughter of Ralph and Maude (Davey) Gentz. She graduated from Blissfield High School with the class of 1938.

On June 16, 1941, Louise married Clyde Sayler. Louise and Clyde celebrated 58 years of marriage prior to his death in 1999.
