ADRIAN – Lucy May Ives, 85, of Adrian died Friday evening, March 19, 2021 at ProMedica Toledo Hospital. Born in Raisin Township on January 28, 1936, she was the daughter of Leroy Hall and Winifred (Crawford) Comfort. She was a 1953 graduate of Adrian High School and a lifelong resident of Adrian.

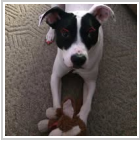
