Ann Arbor, Michigan - Lynne Jane Dawson, 59, of Adrian, Michigan, passed away Tuesday, February 3, 2009 at the Arbor Hospice.

Lynne was born July 22, 1949 in Grosse Pointe Farms, Michigan, the middle child of Christian and Virginia (Ralph) Reinhardt. On June 8, 1996, Lynne married Dr. Michael Dawson of Adrian in Bloomfield Hills, Michigan.

She was a graduate of the University of Michigan, where she was a member of the Kappa Alpha Theta sorority. Prior to her marriage she was a real estate agent in the Detroit area. Lynne was a member of P.E.O, the Adrian Garden Club and Alpha Omega Club where she served as treasurer. First in Lynne's life was family. She also loved crafts, her home, and her St. Bernards, Sasha and Barkley. She did everything with class and touched everyone with her gentle spirit.

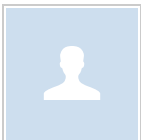

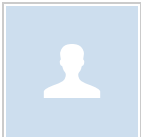

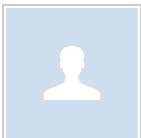

Memories of that 1st Chemo Experience in September 2005:

"Lynne, before leaving on that sunny morning you took a moment to pick an apple from a tree....you let out a little sigh and then giggled. The journey was officially on. As we inched our way towards Ann Arbor, we chatted as though we were on our way to lunch, however, we knew it was much bigger than that. Sometimes it's the things not spoken that are so clearly heard.

After arriving at the hospital, we got a bit sillier. And we did have lunch after all and it was good. The "that was easy" button appeared to be a hit for you and possibly an agitation for the nursing staff. Oh well, "when in doubt, choose to laugh," you said. Your sweet spirit continued to abide and quickly filled the space you were now occupying. Wherever you are, you choose to make the most of it. That is not only admirable but it is one of your finest attributes.

Sunny. Upbeat. Solidly positive.

You are like the perfect Pollyanna, to a tee. We should all be more like you! You encourage our hearts! I will always remember you marching down to your room after your first "lesson" ended, a bit loopy, forging forward. You looked beautiful that day. The new pixie cut and the matching jacket and bag were bright and cheerful! Put together well and organized. You were a sight to behold. Very radiant. Elegant. Sure-footed.

As this journey unfolds, you will surely have those times when you feel agonizingly separated and alone. It is then that I pray you will feel the Father's presence beside you. Reassuring and powerful and holding you tight.

When we are desperately out-of-sorts, He still has a handle on everything. He knows you fully and completely as only a doting Father can. I pray you feel

His love and care wrapping itself around you and providing a shelter from this storm. And that you will

never doubt your worth or beauty or presence in this world. And your purpose. You are a survivor,

a gem, a never-to-be repeated masterpiece! It is all of us who are privileged to experience your loving

touches and all the fun and giggles you bring to those around you.

To your husband. Your kids. Your family and of course, your many, many, many friends who also love and adore you. You are a gift! A

She was such a warrior and we all couldn't be prouder of her efforts, her spirit and how she lived her life. For better or worse, she always made the most of it. Our love and admiration and respect for Lynne runs deep in our souls. There are holes in all our hearts.
