



## Mable Beagle

November 22, 1919 - December 21, 2010

BLISSFIELD – Mable I. Beagle, 91, of Blissfield, passed away Tuesday, December 21, 2010, at Blissfield Place.

Mable was born November 22, 1919, in Riga Township, the daughter of Ralph and Maude (Davey) Gentz. She graduated from Blissfield High School with the Class of 1938.

On October 28, 1939, Mable married Daniel E. Beagle. Mable and Daniel celebrated over 66 years of marriage prior to his death in 2005.

Mable devoted her life to her family. She helped her husband on the farm and was known for her large vegetable garden. Summers were enjoyed at Round Lake where she could fish with Dan, and winters were spent in Fort Myers, Florida. Mable was a faithful member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church.

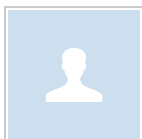
