ADRIAN – Major Herman R. Miller, 85, of Adrian, formerly of Lake City, peacefully went to be with Jesus, with his wife at his side, Tuesday, September 28, 2010.

Herman was born July 12, 1925, in Hicksville, Ohio, the oldest child of Herman D. and Pearl (Rumbaugh) Miller. During World War II he served in the Army.

On September 27, 1947, Herman married Shirlene Muhn in Angola, Indiana. Shirlene, his wife of 63 years, and partner in ministry, survives.

Herman was an officer for The Salvation Army, serving throughout Michigan in Wyandotte, Bay City, Monroe, Jackson, Mt. Clemens, Niles, Sault Ste. Marie, as well as Goshen, Indiana, for many years. He retired in 1990 from his post in Cadillac. Through the remainder of his life he continued his ministry with special services and sharing prayer. He was also a member of the Kiwanis, Rotary, and Lions Clubs.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by three daughters, Terry (David) McClintic of Concord, MI; Beverly Miller and Judith Miller, both of Haslett, MI; two granddaughters, Elizabeth (Ken) Munday and Sarah (Jason) Thiede; a step-granddaughter, Amy Brown; four step great grandchildren; three step

great great grandchildren; and two sisters, Linda (Dan) Frank of Ypsilanti and Gloria Miller of Sterling, IL.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a daughter, Laura, in infancy; and a brother, Harold Miller.

Church Street, Adrian, with Captain Gordon Knight and Major William Cox officiating. Military honors will be conducted by the VFW Annis-Fint Post #1584.
