Margaret Ann “Maggie” (Hayes) Baucher, age 87 of Adrian, Michigan and formerly of Celina, Ohio passed away peacefully on Friday, December 13, 2024 at the Springcreek Rehabilitation and Nursing Center in Adrian, Michigan. She followed all things United States Naval Academy with a passion, especially after her visit there with a grandson in 2018!
