ADRIAN – Margaret A. Miller, age 76, of Adrian, formerly of Hudson, passed away Wednesday, December 16, 2020, at ProMedica Charles & Virginia Hickman Hospital.

She was born May 28, 1944, in Adrian, to Harold and Ruby (Webster) Willett, and graduated from Sand Creek High School in 1962.

On October 5, 1963, she married Olin Miller in Ridgeway, and they recently celebrated 57 years together.

Margaret worked in several different offices including Adrian Steel, Hudson Schools and Gus Harrison Prison where she retired from in 2001. She was a faithful member of Turning Point Church. Margaret loved all things Christmas and celebrated with elaborate decorations and an annual gathering with friends and family. She dearly loved her family and would travel with Olin to high school and college sporting events to cheer on their grandchildren. She and Olin enjoyed several winters in Florida where they could connect with extended family members.

In addition to her husband Olin, she is survived by their children, Larry (Lisa) Miller and Laura Hall, both of Adrian; six grandchildren, Kyle (Sarah) and Garrett Miller, Michaela and Mariah Hall, and Mikayla (Kolton) Alcock and

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by a sister, Martha Endsley, brother, John Willett, and grandson, Joel Miller.

Funeral services will take place at 2 p.m., Monday, December 28, 2020 at Wagley Funeral Home with Pastor Christy Shaw officiating. Burial will be private. Visitation will be held at the funeral home from 11 a.m. until the service at 2.
