GALLATIN, TN - Maria Rocha Montemayor 96 years old, formerly of Adrian, departed this life peacefully on January 15, 2009, at the Gallatin, TN residence of her daughter Trinidad Montemayor. At her side were her two devoted daughters Trinidad Montemayor and Viola Jontz.
