BATTLE CREEK, MI – Marie Ayling, age 95, formerly of Adrian, passed away Thursday, April 9, 2009 in Battle Creek.

Marie was born August 9, 1913 in Tawas, Michigan, the daughter of Oscar and Selma (Larson) Alstrom. After graduating from East Tawas High School, she attended Normal School. In 1946 Marie married Adrian Ayling in Jackson. He preceded her in death in 1964.
