HILLSDALE – Marilyn K. Masson, 85, formerly of Romulus, passed away Wednesday, April 6, 2011, in Hillsdale.

She was born May 22, 1925, in Northampton County, Pennsylvania, the daughter of Joseph and Mary (Pokatello) Koshey. On September 6, 1947, Marilyn married Clarence Masson, Sr. in Detroit. They celebrated 31 years of marriage prior to his death in 1978.

Marilyn received a Master's Degree in Biochemistry from Wayne State University. She taught math and chemistry in the Detroit Public Schools for many years. In her retirement, Marilyn was a full-time pioneer for Jehovah's Witnesses. She was a member of the Brownstown Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses in Taylor, Michigan.
