ADRIAN – Marilyn Jean (Wilt) Moran, 78, of Palmyra passed away peacefully on Saturday, June 26, 2010 at her home, surrounded by her loving family and under the care of Hospice of Lenawee. She was born on July 9, 1931 in Blissfield, Michigan, the daughter of Harlan and Clara (Meirley) Wilt.

Marilyn was the Valedictorian of the Blissfield High School Class of 1949. She was awarded a scholarship, but declined it to work on the family farm. They lived in Toledo, Petersburg and eventually settled in Blissfield in 1964. She and Edward went on to raise 7 sons and 1 daughter, all whom attended Blissfield Schools. She devoted her life to raising her children and tending to her home. Marilyn enjoyed bowling with the girls, reading and spending time with her family.

Surviving is her husband, Edward Moran of Palmyra; 5 children, Eddie (Lorraine) Moran of Toledo, OH, Pat Moran of Palmyra, MI, Brian (Regina) Moran of Sandusky, MI, Kelley (Todd Johnson) Moran of Adrian, MI and Timothy Moran of Orlando, FL; a daughter-in-law, Fayette Steffen of Adrian, MI; 7 grandchildren; 6 great-grandchildren and 1 great-great-grandchild. She was preceded in death by her parents, 3 sons, David Steffen, Michael and Sean Moran and 3 brothers, Elmer, Ray and Norman Wilt.
