



## Marjorie "Marge" Jane Fetsko

December 28, 1939 - August 14, 2025

ADRIAN- Marjorie "Marge" Jane Fetsko, age 85, of Adrian, Michigan, passed away on Thursday, August 14, 2025, at the Hospice of Lenawee Home with the love and support of her family after a courageous battle with cancer.

Marge was born on December 28, 1939, in Tecumseh, MI, she was one of William and Gladys (Dawson) Mitchell's six children. Marge attended Blissfield Community Schools and graduated with the Class of 1959.

On July 15, 1966, Marge was united in marriage to William M. Fetsko in Palmyra, MI. Together they raised three daughters and became loving grandparents to three wonderful grandchildren. Marge and Bill were married for almost 52 years before his death in 2018.

Marge's loving and nurturing personality was an excellent fit for being a care worker at group homes and then was employed with Hope Network before retiring.
