



Marjorie Ann Voorhees Castle

September 16, 1924 - December 8, 2025

ADRIAN- Marjorie Ann Voorhees Castle, at impressive 101 years old, passed away early, Monday, December 8, 2025 at Charlotte Stephenson Manor under the care of Hospice of Lenawee.

She was born at home on September 16, 1924, in Addison, Michigan, the daughter of John D. and Lida D. (Marry) Voorhees. Marjorie attended Addison Community Schools while growing up and graduated with the Class of 1942 where she was Valedictorian. She went on to attend Siena Heights College. On May 19, 1948 Marjorie married Dennis L. "Jiggs" Castle in Jackson, Michigan. Together they raised two daughters. They were blessed with over 72 years together when Jiggs passed away in 2020.

Marjorie's career was in the medical field, starting out as an x-ray technologist at Addison Community Hospital from 1943-1964. Her leadership and organizational skills were a great fit as she went on to manage the Bixby Radiology office in 1965 and retired after 20 years in 1985.

Marjorie believed in giving back to her community and gave of her time and talents in many ways. She was involved with the Girl Scouts, 4-H, Adrian Business & Professional Women, Lenawee Historical Society, Addison Community Hospital and Bixby Auxillary, Project Lead, Adrian Community Nursery Board, Lenawee Council for the Visual Arts, Chapter DK-PEO, Lucy Wolcott DAR, Daughters of American Colonists, and Lenawee Country Club. When Marjorie wasn't volunteering, she enjoyed reading, bridge, painting, golf, ceramics, traveling with the Overlanders and her family.

She is survived by her daughter, Jane (Tom Boldt) Castle; son-in-law, Richard Seager; and Henriksen family cousins. Marjorie was preceded in death by her husband, Dennis, and daughter, Sherry Ann Seager; and brother, John Voorhees.

A memorial celebration will be held on Friday, December 12, 2025, from 4 to 6 p.m. in the Heritage Room at Wagley Funeral Home, Adrian. Private burial will be at Dibble Cemetery at a later date.
