BLISSFIELD- Mary Fischer, 76, passed away Monday, December 5, 2022 at ProMedica Charles & Virginia Hickman Hospital,

She was born on April 19, 1946, in Adrian, Michigan the daughter of Arthur “Darl” and Gertrude M. (Welker) Pfeffer. Mary graduated from Deerfield High School with the Class of 1964.

Mary had a natural talent for painting and carving that showed her artistic side. Mary liked to test her luck in playing Bingo, Keno and

taking part in regular trips to the casinos.
