ADRIAN – Mary Damon Haney, age 85 of Adrian, passed away Wednesday, March 9, 2016, at Promedica Bixby Hospital.

She was born March 21, 1930, in Adrian, Michigan to Richard and Viola “Pearl” (Shreffler) Damon. Mary graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1948, and was a member of the 1951 graduating class at Harper Hospital School of Nursing.

On July 7, 1952, Mary was married to Thomas Haney in Adrian, and they have shared over 63 years together.

Mary was a faithful member of the First Presbyterian Church in Adrian where she served in many capacities including as Clerk of Session for 20 years, choir director for 14 years, and as an elder. She was a member of the Women’s Life Group and Matinee Musicale, as well as a former member of the Literary Club. As a nurse, Mary worked mostly in the intensive care unit at Bixby Hospital, choosing to work part time so she could be home to raise her family.

In addition to her husband, Tom, she is survived by their children: Richard Haney of Adrian and Mary (Robert) Gilhouse of Riverside, California; two grandsons, Zachary (Kayla) Gilhouse and Benjamin Gilhouse; great grandchildren, Chloe and William; a sister, Joyce Ferguson of Tecumseh, and sister-in-law, Fern Damon.

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by a brother, David Damon. Funeral services will take place at 11:00 a.m., Saturday, March 12, 2016, at

Wagley Funeral Home with Rev. Sarah Ross officiating. Burial will be private. Visitation will be held at the funeral home on Friday from 2 to 4 p.m. and 6 to 8 p.m.
