BLISSFIELD – Mary Ellen Ickler Saylor, age 83 of Blissfield, passed away Sunday, November 9, 2014 at Promedica Bixby Hospital.

She was born August 11, 1931, in Ann Arbor, Michigan. At 6 weeks she was adopted by David and Edna (Rathbun) Loar. She graduated from Blissfield High School in 1948.
