ADRIAN—Maurice (“Morey”) Orville Parker, 90, of Adrian passed away on Saturday, May 28, 2016 at home, surrounded by his family.

He was born in Toledo, to Arthur and Elsie (Shepherd) Parker on July 29, 1925. Maurice enlisted in the Navy and proudly served his country from 1943 to 1946, during World War II as a Field Medic, working in the contagious disease ward, helping to build the hospital in Guam.

Upon his return from service, he married his sweetheart and love of his life, Dorothy Etter on August 8, 1947 in Angola, IN. They were blessed with over 68 years of marriage; Dorothy survives.

Maurice was a member of Hope Lutheran Church and the VFW Post 97. He was a lifelong farmer and truly had a passion for it. He raised livestock in his younger years. Maurice was a lift truck driver for Simplex for over 42 years, until his retirement in 1988.

In addition to his wife, Dorothy, he is survived by his children: Gary Parker of Adrian and Linda Kindinger of Cape Coral, Florida; grandchildren: Shad Parker of Toledo; Jason (Michelle) Counts of Adrian; Tawnya (Paul) Gregoire of Adrian; Corey Kindinger of Westland, MI; and Adam (Rebecca) Parker of Adrian; 8 great-grandchildren; and 3 great-great- grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his brothers: Arthur, Merlyn, and Larry Parker; and sister, Adrienne (“Gail”) Bacon.

Funeral services for Maurice will be 11 am, Friday, June 3, 2016, at Wagley Funeral Home with Pastor Paul Herter officiating. Burial will follow in Palmyra
