BLISSFIELD – Maxine A. Eastman, age 85 of Blissfield, formerly of Westland, Michigan, passed away Saturday, November 30, 2013, at Blissfield Place where she happily lived the past 6 years surrounded by wonderful care givers and residents she considered dear friends.
