Mike was born in Adrian on July 14, 1943 to John Henry and Lois M. (Morey) Frye. Growing up Mike walked to Ganun country school in Palmyra with his siblings and later attended Blissfield High School.

Mike loved working the land and farmed for most of his life in Britton, MI. He was a man of organization, and everything had a place. Mike took great care as a model maker in the model shop at Tecumseh Products, and later in life he worked for a cleaning service.

Known for having an easy-going personality, Mike could strike up a conversation with anyone as he never knew a stranger. He was especially close to his cousin, Mervin Slater, of Canada, and the two talked frequently on the phone. Mike enjoyed playing cards and was a true animal lover, caring for many dogs and cats over the years. He attended Immanuel Lutheran Church in Palmyra.

Mike is survived by his siblings, Kimball (Beverly) Frye of Adrian, Elona Frye of Palmyra and Nola Frye of Peru, IN; and many nieces, nephews and cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents, grandparents, several

aunts and his former wife, Carol.
