ADRIAN – Mina E. Marlatt, age 93 of Palmyra, passed away Monday, March 28, 2016 at Magnumcare of Adrian.

She was born January 12, 1923 in Adrian, Michigan, the only daughter of John and Mary (Etter) Roesch. Mina graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1941.

On September 20, 1941, Mina married Clyde E. Marlatt in Adrian. He preceded her in death in 2002 having celebrated over 60 years together.

Mina retired from Bixby Medical Center where she had worked as a dietary aide and cook for 20 years. She was a faithful member of Palmyra Presbyterian Church where she was involved in the Stitch and Chatter Club.

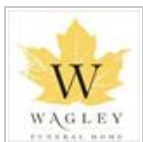

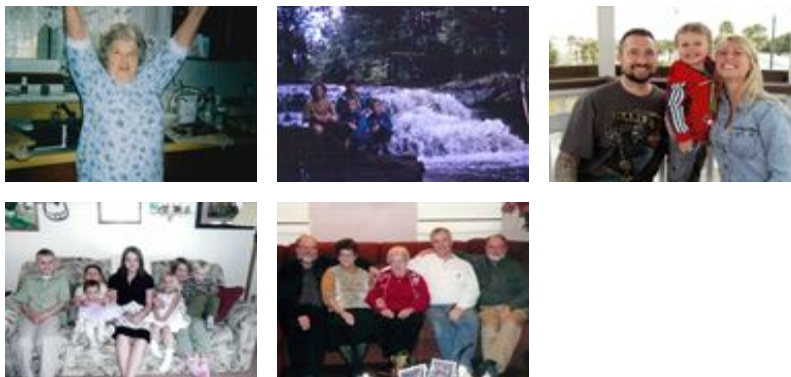
