Nancy Glaser, 83, passed away Wednesday, May 25, 2011, at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor.

She was born June 11, 1927, in Hillsdale, Michigan, the daughter of the late Edward and Gladys (Howd) Williams. She graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1944, received her Bachelor's Degree from the University of Michigan, and a Master's Degree from Siena Heights.

On June 10, 1948, Nancy married Judge Kenneth Glaser, Jr. in Adrian. They celebrated 53 years of marriage prior to his death in 2002.

Nancy taught at Lincoln Elementary in Adrian. She retired in 1987 from Madison Public Schools where she was a counselor at the high school.

Nancy was a faithful member of the First United Methodist Church where she served as a Stephens Minister. She was also a member of Lucy Wolcott Barnum Chapter of the DAR, P.E.O., Kappa Kappa Epsilon, Alpha Omega, the Garden Club, and the Monday Literary Club

Nancy is survived by her children: Rebecca (Gilbert) Ledesma of Holt, MI; Kenneth (Kim) Glaser III of Allendale, MI; Rev. William (Miala) Glaser of Austin, MN; John (Annette) Glaser of Adrian; Tim Glaser also of Adrian; and

In addition to her husband, Nancy was preceded in death by a sister, Betsy Weldon.
