ADRIAN – Nancy L. LaVoy, age 83 of Adrian, died Thursday, October 10, 2024, at Charlotte Stephenson Manor.

She was born January 15, 1941, in Monroe, Michigan, the daughter of Howard and Irene (Schmidt) Feinauer and graduated from Dundee High School with the Class of 1959.
