ADRIAN- Nancy Jean Shipman, 75, of Adrian, passed away Monday, September 21, 2020, at ProMedica Toledo Hospital, the result of a recent stroke. She was born February 24, 1945, in Adrian, the daughter of the late David and Alberta (Cole) Shipman.

Nancy was a 1963 graduate of Sand Creek High School, and has enjoyed monthly gatherings at local restaurants with her classmates. She worked in accounts payable for several organizations including Dura Corporation, La-Z-Boy and Stauffer Chemical. An active member of First Church of the Nazarene, Nancy was president of the missionary board, was a participant in the Africa and Panama mission trips and also assisted in meals for the church's weekly drug recovery program.
