ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA – Nicholas S. Johnson, age 26 of St. Petersburg, FL, passed away December 29, 2013.

Nicholas was born October 5, 1987 in Norfolk, Virginia, to John “Scott” and Mary “Kathy” (Knadler) Johnson.

He graduated from Wilmot Union High School in Wisconsin with the Class of 2006 and went on to earn an associate’s degree in auto mechanics. 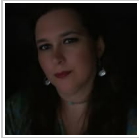
