Norma accepted Christ as her Saviour and leader in life at the Panther Creek First Church of the Brethren in Adel, Iowa. She served the Lord in this church while playing her marimba, reciting readings, teaching Bible school and Sunday school beginning at age 13 years.

After graduating from Linden Consolidated High School, as Valedictorian, with the class of 1946, Norma attended Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa and Denver University in Denver, Colorado and briefly at Adrian College in Adrian, Michigan.
