ADRIAN- Norma Jean, 93, of Adrian, Michigan flew to heaven on Friday, November 24, 2023 at Adrian Bay Rehab and Nursing Center.

Norma was born on April 26, 1930 to Glenn and Mamie (Stone) Van Etten in Ogden Township, MI. On February 9, 1948 Norma married Howard W. Prielipp at the home of Otis and Helen Gloff in Dundee, MI. They were married for 30 years before Howard's passing. Norma was fortunate and found love again and married Maurice E. Kramer on December 29, 1981. Norma worked for General Telephone Company in Adrian as a telephone operator from 1946 to 1985, retiring after 39 years of service. Norma accepted the Lord in October 1956 and stated, "I know I am going to Heaven, and I am not afraid to die." She followed in Christ's footsteps and was a prayer warrior. Norma attended New Hope Tabernacle and Bethany Assembly of God in Adrian. Norma felt led to work with the elderly. In 1997 she became a volunteer at Lenawee Medical Center delivering mail, newspapers and played a card game "Spite and Malice" with the residents. The staff remember Norma for her shoulder rubs. She retired in May of 2011.

She is survived by her daughters, Wilma Jean Prielipp (Mike) Millage of Tecumseh, Michigan and Judith Lynne (Robert) Randall of Indianapolis, IN; 9

grandchildren, 23 great-grandchildren and 2 great great-grandchildren. Norma was preceded in death by her husbands, Howard W. Prielipp, Maurice E. Kramer, son Howard Douglas Prielipp; her four sisters, Maxine Poucher, Eva McLoughlin, Glendora Walters and Nina Le Veque.
