



## Norman Engel Harrington Jr.

February 24, 1935 - March 25, 2024

ADRIAN- Norman Engel Harrington, Jr., age 89, of Adrian, Michigan died early Monday morning, March 25, 2024 at his daughter's home under the care of Hospice of Lenawee.

Norm was born on February 24, 1935 in Adrian, MI, the oldest child of Norman E. and Margaret F. (McMaster) Harrington, Sr. Norm graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1953.

On September 21, 1957 Norm married Janice Ann Moore at Adrian First Baptist Church and they have shared 66 years together.

Norm's life revolved around the newspaper industry, and he saw many changes over the years. He started out as a paperboy, delivering papers to residents in Adrian. As soon as he was old enough, Norm worked as a printer for the Daily Telegram and from there he went to Swenk-Tuttle Press for over 30 years. During his career he started out using lead print for the newspapers and by the time he retired, computers were being utilized for all newspaper printing.

When it was time to relax, Norm could be found out on the golf course, where he played on several leagues. In his retirement years, Norm stayed busy outside in the sunshine mowing the tees and greens at Wolf Creek Golf Course. He treasured the memories and friendships he made through golfing; with his wife, Janice, being his favorite golfing partner. Norm belonged to the Adrian Moose Lodge #1034. He was a devoted Michigan Wolverine fan and attended a game this past fall with his son, Todd and brother-in-law, Ed, where

In addition to his wife, Janice, Norm is survived by their children, Todd (Vivian) Harrington and Paula Loftin; grandchildren, Alicia, Joe David, Emily and Lauren; 10 great-grandchildren; and brother, Michael Harrington. Norm was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Meredith.
